INTEREST RATES AND INTEREST CHARGES	
Annual Percentage Rate (APR) for Purchases and Cash Advances	4.90% Introductory APR for 6 months from date of account opening. After that, your APR will be 9.90%-20.90% based on your creditworthiness.
Annual Percentage Rate (APR) for Balance Transfers	0% Promotional APR for 6 months on balance transfers made during January or February of 2023. After that, and for all other balance transfers, APR will be 9.90%-20.90% when you open your account based on your creditworthiness.
Penalty APR and When it Applies	20.90% This APR may be applied to your account if you make a late payment. How Long Will the Penalty APR Apply? If your APR is increased for this reason, the Penalty APR will apply until you make six consecutive minimum payments when due.
Paying Interest	Your due date is approximately 25 days after the close of each billing cycle. We will not charge any interest on the portion of the purchases balance that you pay by the due date each month. We will begin charging interest on cash advances and balance transfers on the transaction date.
